The album was directly inspired by Donny's own unique career journey of constant reinvention over the course of his run as a globally recognized performer.

Chosen by the public as winner of Best Show, Best Performer, Best Resident Headliner and Best Production in the Best of Las Vegas honors from The Las Vegas Review Journal, Osmond's show is an exciting, energy-filled musical journey of his unparalleled life as one of the most recognized entertainers in the world. Mike Campbell & The Dirty Knobs

Performing songs off their first two records *Wreckless Abandon* (2020) and *External Combustion* (2022), as well as classics from his beloved previous band, Mike Campbell (Tom Petty and The Heartbreakers, Fleetwood Mac) will be joined by drummer Steve Ferrone, guitarist/keyboardist Chris Holt and bassist Lance Morrison who make up The Dirty Knobs.

What began as a less structured project for Campbell in between The Heartbreakers' touring schedule became a full-time project following the passing of Campbell's longtime compatriot, friend and bandmate Tom Petty.

Mike Campbell & The Dirty Knobs have spent the last three years touring the country headlining legendary venues such as the Fillmore in San Francisco, CA and Capitol Theatre in Port Chester, NY while also supporting icons including Chris Stapleton, The Who and Willie Nelson.

In September 2023, Mike Campbell & The Dirty Knobs, along with fellow Tom Petty & The

Heartbreakers founding member Benmont Tench, were the backing band to musical legend Bob Dylan in his surprise appearance at Farm Aid 2023 – his first time back since the festival's inaugural event in 1985. Performing his hits "Maggie's Farm," "Positively 4th Street," and "Ballad of a Thin Man," attendees saw Dylan play the guitar for the first time in many years, marking the entire performance as a moment which Rolling Stone dubbed "the highlight of an epic show."

Opening in 2011, the Kauffman Center serves as a cultural cornerstone for extraordinary and diverse music, opera, theater and dance performances for Kansas City and the region. Designed by internationally recognized architect Moshe Safdie, the Kauffman Center has been honored as one of the World's 15 Most Beautiful Concert Halls, which attracts some of the world's most renowned performers and entertainers. The 285,000-square-foot Center includes two performance halls: the 1,800-seat Muriel Kauffman Theatre that hosts dance performances, operas, plays, and musicals and the 1,600-seat Helzberg Hall, a venue for a wide range of musical performances, from chamber music to full orchestral concerts, jazz and pop, lectures, and recitals.

The Kauffman Center is the performance home for three of the region's leading performing arts organizations – Kansas City Ballet, Lyric Opera of Kansas City, Kansas City Symphony. In addition, the *Kauffman Center Presents* series brings in performing artists at the top of their classes as well as *Trailblazing Talks*, a live speaker series.
