Nick Mason’s Saucerful of Secrets is composed of Nick Mason, Spandau Ballet guitarist Gary Kemp, longtime Pink Floyd touring bassist Guy Pratt, guitarist Lee Harris and keyboardist Dom Beken. The band earned rave reviews throughout its debut North American tour in 2019, so audiences won’t want to miss this rare opportunity to experience **Pink Floyd’s** celebrated and significant early body of work.
